
THE MUBS ENERGY ECONOMICS RESOURCES CENTRE

The Energy Economics Resources Centre (EERC) of Makerere University Business School (MUBS) was established in 2022 as a measure of ensuring the sustainability of the capacity building in research and energy modeling activities in Uganda. This follows the

capacity building foundation that was created through the collaboration between MUBS and the Norwegian University of Life sciences (NMBU), under the support of the Norwegian Agency for Development Cooperation (Norad) relating to the successful implementation of Norad supported NORHED I and II projects. The Centre is aimed at supporting training and research with particular priority at modeling energy transitions and with a focus on the three Ds: Decarbonization. Decentralization and Digitalization. These represent the core challenges to the development and energy policy, policy analysis, regulation, business operations and investment in the sector. Thus, a new set of knowledge and tools is required to understand, participate and influence energy transition. Therefore, the EERC's overall mission is to support increased competencies in energy economics, applied research and stakeholder engagement towards affordable, clean and reliable lowercarbon energy systems in Uganda.
