MUBS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES 2019/2020 NOW ON

MUBS is inviting applications for the 2019/2020 academic year for Persons With Disabilities Scholarships.

Objectives of the policy

- i. To identify Students with Disabilities and promote scholarship with a view of easing the attainment of an education by Persons with Disabilities.
- ii. To facilitate academic development not only in the institution but also in the country.
- iii. To promote learning.

What does the scholarship cover?

- i. The Scholarship will cover 100% tuition waiver but the beneficiary will be required to pay the requisite functional fees.
- ii. The beneficiary of the fellowship should not be on another Sponsorship scheme.
- iii. The fellowship is valid for a period of one academic year and is renewable annually (twice for undergraduate programmes) subject to satisfactory performance.
- iv. The fellowship must be completed within (3) three years for Bachelors programmes and (2) two years for Ordinary Diploma programmes; retakes are not covered by the scholarship.
- v. Termination can be by either party when one party fails to meet the requirements of the fellowship.
- vi. The offer of the scholarship cannot be carried forward (cannot be deferred). If the successful application wishes to be considered for the next academic year, he/she will be required to make a fresh application.
- vii. All university regulations apply through the duration of the scholarship.

Who is eligible to apply?

- One must have an Admission Letter to one of the MUBS programmes for the current academic year.
- One must be on a degree programme jointly offered by Makerere University and MUBS or Ordinary Diploma programme offered and taught at MUBS Main Campus or its Regional Campuses in Mbale, Jinja, Arua and Mbarara.
- iii. One must be a MUBS Student with a Disability; according to the National Council for Disability Act 2003, a Disability is a functional limitation of daily life activities of an individual caused by physical, sensory or mental impairment and environmental barriers.
- iv. One must be a citizen of Uganda not more than (30) years of age (applicants for bachelor's degree programmes) or twenty (24) years of age (applicants for ordinary diploma programmes) at the time of application.
- v. The candidate must provide their Uganda National Examinations Board (UNEB) UCE and UACE Results Slips and Certificates or their equivalent and Diploma transcripts /Certificates for verification.
